- ONE APPLICATION FORM PER PERSON (You will only be permitted to submit one family's application form per person)
- A COPY OF YOUR CHILD'S IMMUNISATION RECORD MUST BE AN OFFICIAL LETTER FROM MEDICARE or a CONSCIENTIOUS OR MEDICAL OBJECTION FORM (a copy of the blue book will not be sufficient, due to our Regulations)
- · IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO SUBMIT YOUR ENROLMENT FORM PERSONALLY, YOU WILL NEED TO ORGANISE SOMEONE ELSE TO DO THIS FOR YOU (we will NOT accept any enrolment submissions before 7.30am on Monday 4th November 2013, under any circumstances)

School Bus 606 - Update!



The new 606 bus route has now been in operation for over two weeks and so far has been a huge success! Most days the bus is close to capacity and the school is receiving new enquiries and bus pass applications every day.

The new route is certainly catering for the school community!

Like with anything new, there have been some minor teething issues and some 'tweaking' of the route may still need to take place ... stay tuned.

There is currently a gap in bus stops between Military Rd near Dover Rd (Dover Heights) and Mitchell St near O'Donnell St (North Bondi). The school is working with Sydney Buses and Waverley Council to install additional bus stops on Lyons Rd and Hardy St. In the meantime children will not be able to alight from the bus along this part of the route (approximately 1.3 km). We will keep you posted of developments on this front.

A map of the new route and a current list of bus stops are attached.

If you live along or near the route we strongly urge you to consider using the bus for your child. A teacher is on duty every afternoon to supervise children as they wait for and board the bus. Many parents of younger children are now opting to meet their child at the bus stop rather than driving all the way to school. The bus is a great way to reduce congestion and relieve parking stresses!

Bus pass application forms are available at the office.

Thank you to all school families for your patience and understanding as we get used to the new arrangements.
