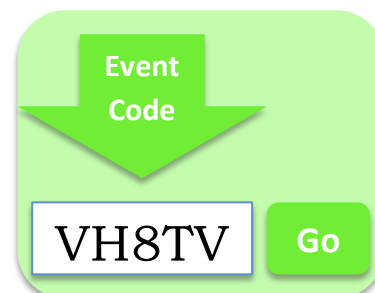

These children are in dire need of a break for a variety of reasons and circumstances. During their 12 day visit they are cared for and experience an environment that builds on their self esteem, resilience and well being.

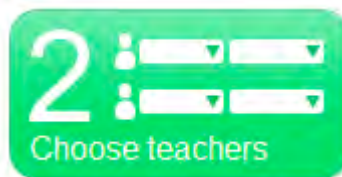

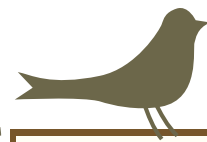

## Working bee in our school garden!



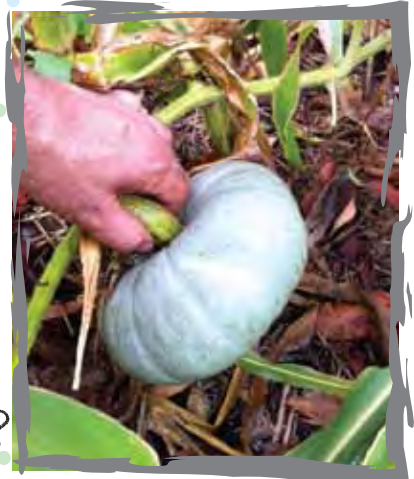

**Please Note:** To be eligible to apply, candidates must be Australian Citizens or holders of a visa granting permanent resident status in Australia on the day of their audition.


