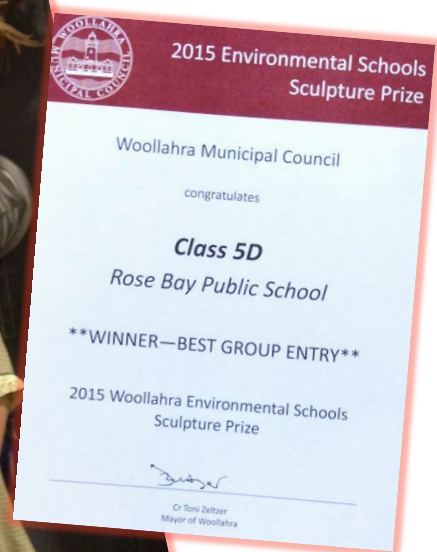

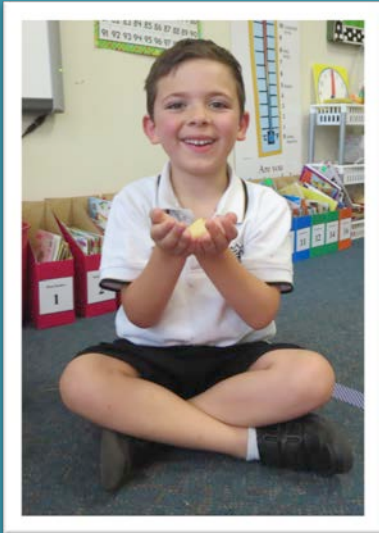
Walking through the gallery we are in awe,

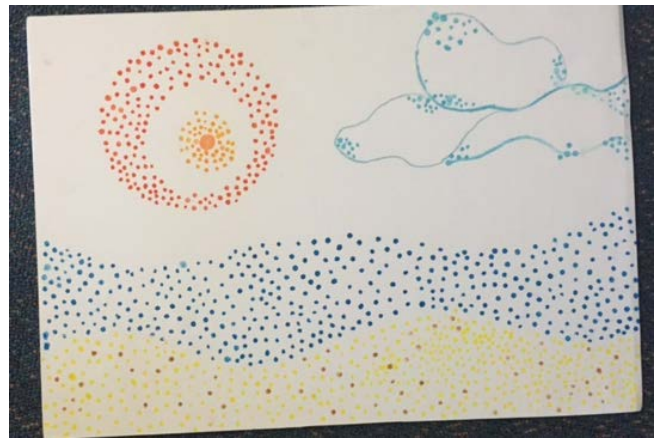
# matthew jones art award
