If your child receives a place in one of our three REDed RBPS Troupes, payment in full is required by Wednesday 31 January 2018. A contract will be provided to all parents for signature to confirm commitment. REDed has an 80% minimum attendance policy with 100% attendance expected. This is a full year commitment. Refunds are not applicable. Any unpaid fees at time of commencement will require dancer to forfeit position to another dancer on short list.

chocolate wrapper
cheese and cracker packet
glad wrap
zip lock bag

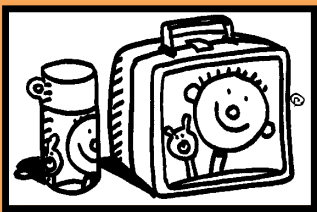
challah bread Ingredients:

plain flour 1 kg
yeast 17 g
warm water $1\frac{3}{4}$
olive oil $\frac{1}{2}$ cup
salt 1 tsp
2 eggs
sugar $\frac{2}{3}$ cup

plus healthy

- Mix the Yeast with the flour and make sure there are no clumps.
- add the rest of the ingredients. Add dry first, then wet.
- need dough for 5-10 mins and let it rise for an hour in hot area.
- plate bread, cover with glad wrap and rise in weak oven about 30 mins.
- take bread out, egg wash and top with sesame.
- turn oven up to 180°C and cook for approx 1 hour.
- cool and use in sandwiches etc.

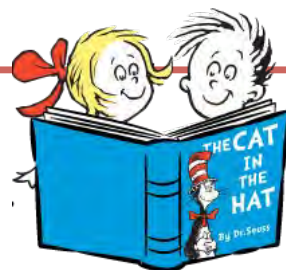
