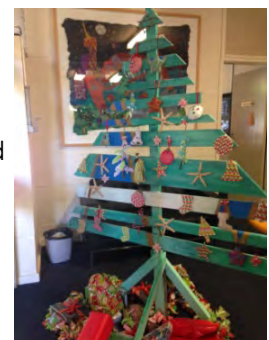
Our Giving Tree

- Some water

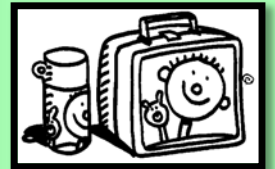
EQUIPMENT!

STEPS

1. Preheat oven to 180°C
2. Place pasta and lentils into baking dish in layers.
3. Mix tomato paste, onion in a bowl, add water and microwave for 2 minutes on high
4. Spread sauce over pasta and lentils until covered and season with garlic salt
5. Sprinkle with cheese
6. Bake for 20 minutes until cheese is brown
7. Eat! or pack in your lunchbox (with a reusable fork)!
