An aspect of learning that we increasingly talk about is the importance of quality learning experiences in STEM. The focus is on integrating the learning across these disciplines and approaching learning from an inquiry point of view.

I was delighted to share in these learning experiences. Students from K-6 participated in a range of collaborative learning experiences which included transporting programmable robots (Dash and Sphero) across a void through the design and engineering of bridges, analysing and replicating the movement of particles through coding and applying mathematical thinking to create varied solutions to identify distances, speed and amount of rotation in order to successfully travel from destinations combating hazards along the way.

Students displayed great problem solving, initiative and critical and creative thinking. All students enthusiastically participated in these hands-on experiences and gained a deeper knowledge of how Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics interrelate.

Thank you to all of the teachers who made this great week of learning take place.

School Finance

School finances are a tricky beast. As a school, our teachers always wish to provide a varied and stimulating curriculum and at times, this incurs a fee, particularly for special events, excursions or performances.



However, we currently have \$85,000 in fees outstanding for the year. To put in in perspective, this is roughly the equivalent of a teacher 4 days per week. Or the cost to install another set of interactive whiteboards.

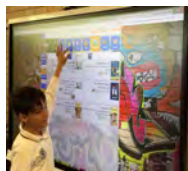
It would also be remiss of me not to thank Vicki and Alex for their professional manner in handling payments and invoice queries (on top of all the other things they do).

Thank you to all those who were involved. Your valuable contribution supports the school in educating your children.



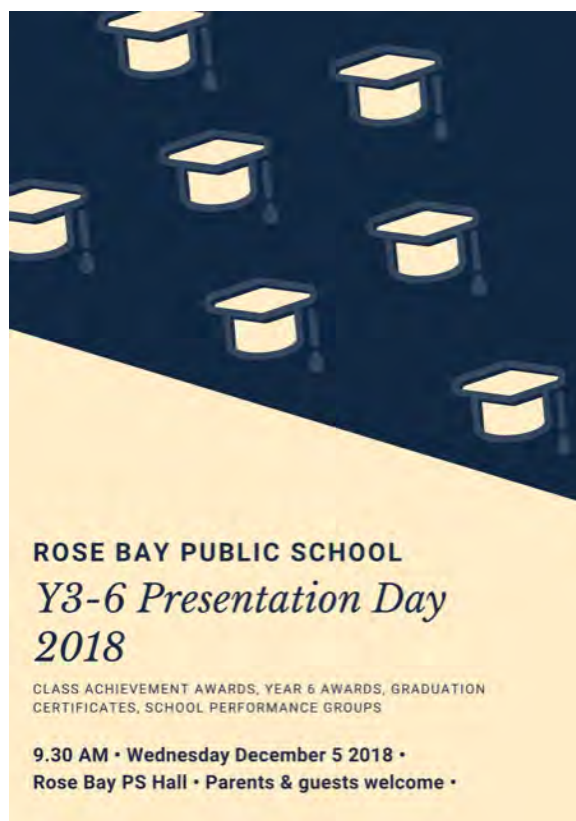
Smart boards
