Does your child have a mobile device?

At Rose Bay Public School all mobile phones are to be kept inside school bags and switched off during school hours.

We understand that some students need to carry a mobile device for travel to or from school. However, it is important that students do not use these devices during school hours.

The procedures applying to the inappropriate use of mobile phones apply equally to the inappropriate use of tablets, portable computer games, iPods, watches and similar devices.

This is a potentially life threatening condition. Please do not send any of the following foods for your own children, whilst they are at school

- Peanuts and other nuts including cashews, hazelnuts, walnuts, pistachios, macadamia, brazil nuts
- Peanut Butter or Nutella
- Muesli bars containing nuts or any other foods containing nuts.

Even if we believe our dogs are placid, we cannot afford the risk of agitation by a child or vice versa. For this reason and the general safety of all our students, dogs are not permitted on our school grounds, including drop-off and pick-up times. Regardless of size or temperament, and whether a dog is on or off a leash or carried, no dogs are permitted on the grounds. Please do not tie dogs up at the entrance.
