
#### **National Reconciliation Week**

#### What is National Reconciliation Week?

National Reconciliation Week (NRW) is a time for all Australians to learn about our shared histories, cultures, and achievements, and to explore how each of us can contribute to achieving reconciliation in Australia. The dates for NRW remain the same each year; 27 May to 3 June. These dates commemorate two significant milestones in the reconciliation journey— the successful 1967 referendum, and the High Court Mabo decision respectively.

Reconciliation must live in the hearts, minds and actions of all Australians as we move forward, creating a nation strengthened by respectful relationships between the wider Australian community, and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.

Teachers set up an outdoor library, one for K-2 under the Kinder COLA and another for 3-6 on grass area where the students could read books based on Aboriginal culture and then have a 'yarn' about what they learnt. The students also shared stories and participated in learning activities in the classroom and library about reconciliation and to learn about Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander histories and cultures.

Our Year 5 historians had a great time designing artefacts based on life in Australia post 1800's. Well done Year 5! Your teachers are very proud of your efforts!



























## Walk Safely To School Day
