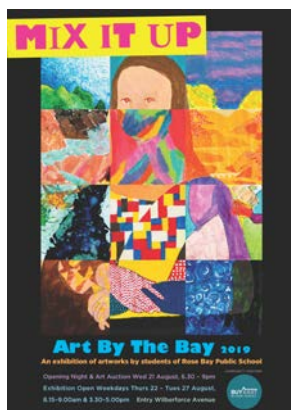
School Newsletter – 14th August 2019 Term 3 Week 4

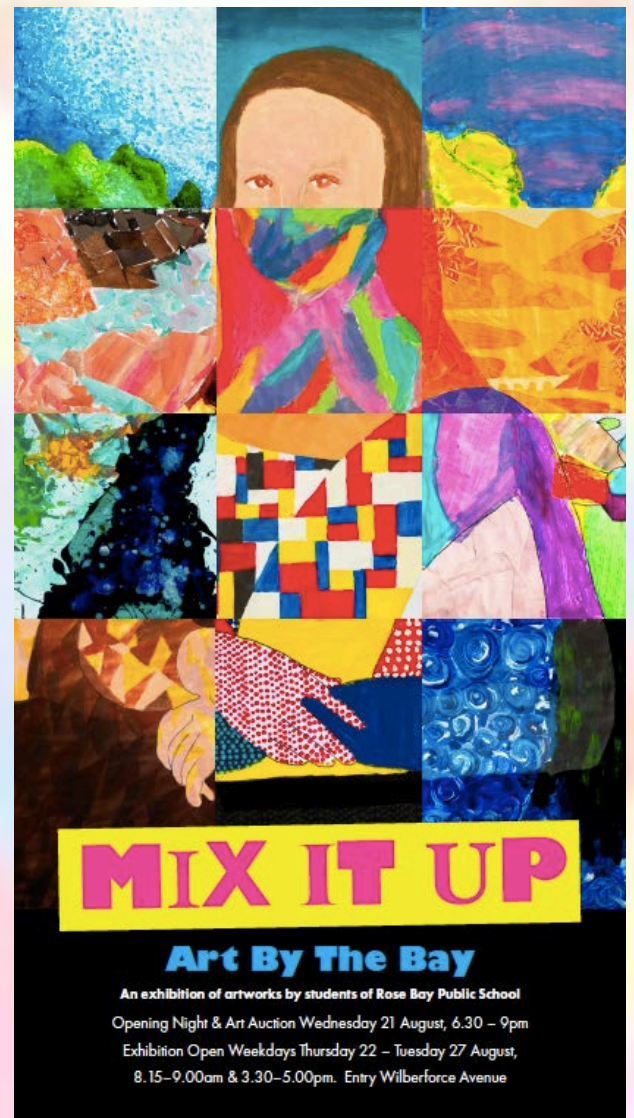

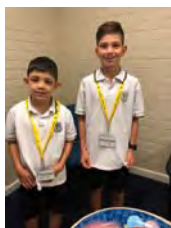

Nationally Consistent Collection of Data

The Nationally Consistent Collection of Data (NCCD) is an annual collection that counts the number of school students receiving an adjustment due to disability and the level of adjustment they are receiving to access education on the same basis as other students. All government and non-government schools in Australia are required to participate.

The national data collection aims to lead to nationally consistent, high quality data that will enable schools, education authorities and governments to gain a more complete understanding of students who are receiving adjustments because of disability in schools in Australia and how best to support them.

Protecting the privacy and confidentiality of all of our students and families is essential. Personal details such as student names or other identifying information will not be provided. All data will be submitted by the 16th August 2019. 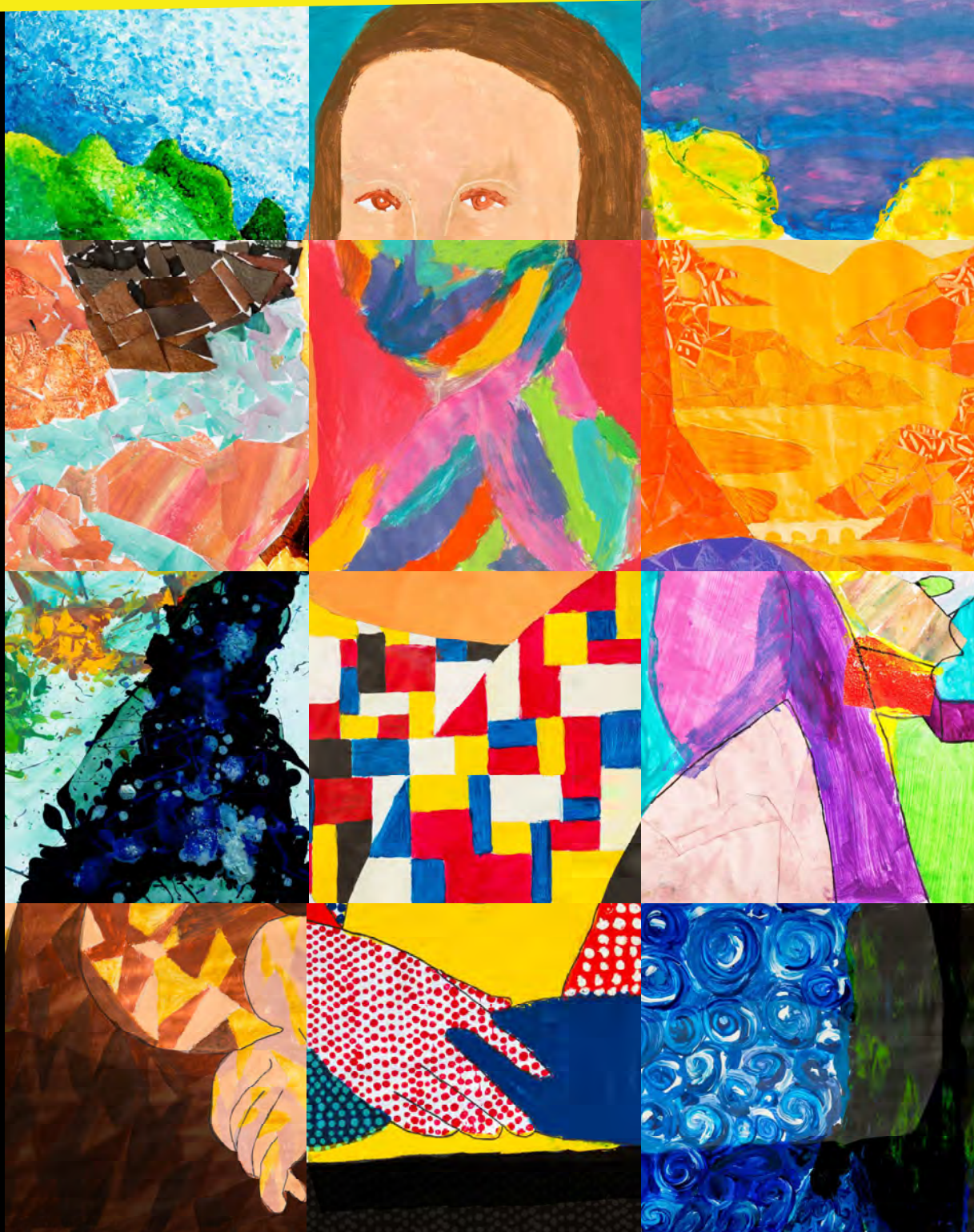
