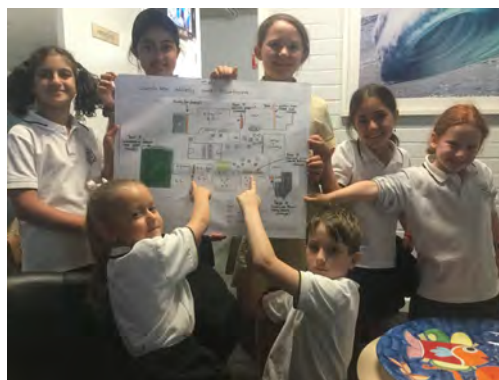
I look forward to welcoming you to celebrate your many successes from throughout the year.

During these sessions parents were able to experience firsthand some of the creative iPad learning tasks students in Year 4 actively engage in. For those unable to attend, take a look at some of the completed student examples on the following pages.



During the sessions we showcased how RBPS staff utilise **Apple Classroom** to manage devices and ensure greater visibility. This application allows teachers to access students learning through screen view, create groupings for easy distribution of resources, pause and lock devices to gain student attention, and even lock students into an application to minimise distractions.

STATION 1

CREATE A PERSONIFIED PICTURE

We are experimenting with personification by creatively applying human characteristics to everyday objects. Use the built-in Markup tools in Photos to draw facial features, write text, or attach other elements that will help bring your object to life.

1. Using the , take a photo of an everyday item.

2. In , select the image you want to personify.


3. Click on **EDIT**, located in the north-east corner of the screen.

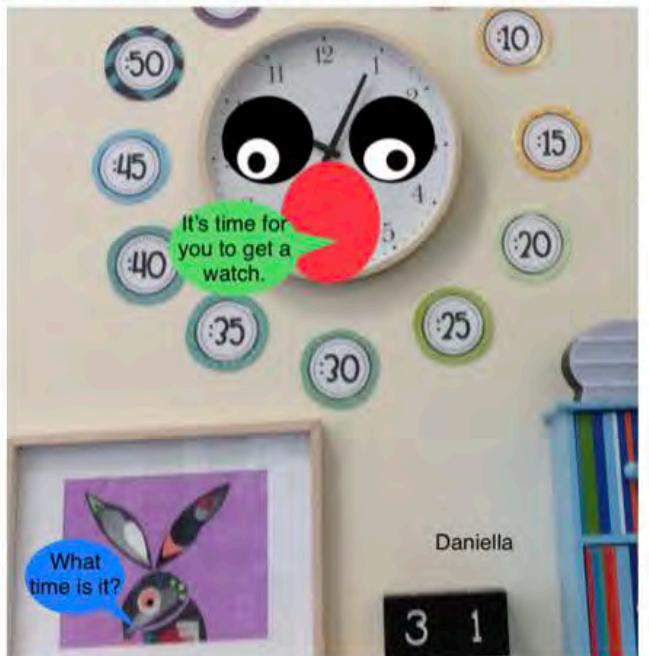
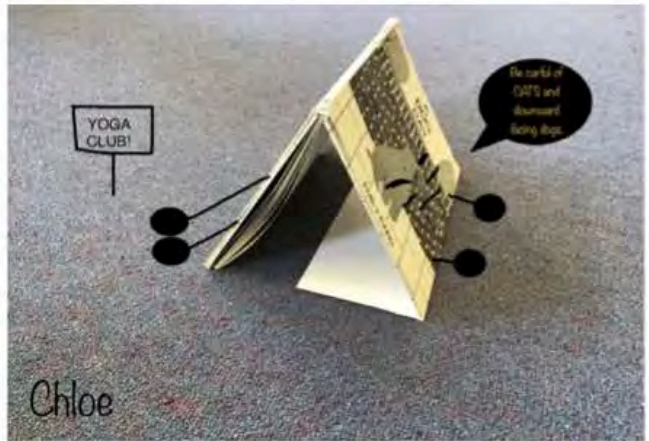
4. Select the more icon  followed by Markup .

5. Using the tools available ...

6. Click on the  icon located in the south-east corner to add shapes and text.



STATION 2

CREATING MULTIMODAL TEXTS

Today we are experimenting with visual, multimodal and digital processes to represent ideas encountered in texts.

1. Use  to illustrate the setting for your narrative.
2. In  select the  icon located in the north-east corner.
3. Locate media selector  in your toolbar, choose **PHOTOS** and upload your images.
4. Click on the image you want to modify, select format  **Image** and then  **Image** and then  **Image** in order to remove the background (this will help with layering images). Move the cursor over the areas you want to make transparent.
5. Tap an image. Scroll through the options provided and select **ANIMATE**. Use **Magic Move**  or **Create Path** to show movement.
6. Remember to edit the speed and build sequence to ensure it's just right.
7. **Publish** your narrative and **add voice recordings**.

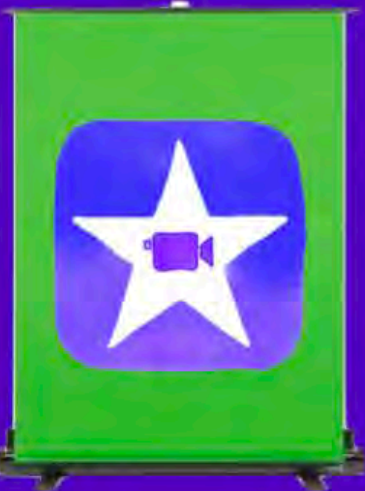

Stand back and watch as your video is superimposed over an image or even another video clip.




