Car Pick-Up Line

This is a reminder for all families who use the Go with the Flow pick-up line. The No Parking sign on Wilberforce Avenue means you can park for 2 minutes only and not leave the vicinity of your car. It is best to arrive in this area when the bell goes at 3.20 and your child is waiting so that you are not parked any longer than necessary. If you arrive early, please find a park in a nearby street and walk to your child's pick-up area/gate.

The Go with the Flow area works well when cars arrive from 3.20 - 3.30. There is a teacher on duty between these times to supervise the students waiting.

Police are currently patrolling all schools in the area and fining those who park and drive illegally .
