Return to School Monday 25 May 2020

Dear Rose Bay Families,

As you would be aware, students return to full time face-to-face learning from this Monday 25 May. NSW government health officials continue to remind us of the importance of maintaining physical distancing requirements especially for adults. In order to meet these physical distancing requirements and to assist with a safe transition back to school for all, Rose Bay has developed a return to school plan incorporating a staggered finish-with Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 finishing each day at 3pm.

Morning drop off

From Monday morning, the teachers and school executive will meet you at any of the school gates and welcome your child onto the school grounds. We ask that you drop your child at the gate in a kiss-and-drop fashion. The playground will be supervised from 8.45am as usual.

Kindergarten should enter via the Wilbeforce gate to be met by Mrs Dooner and the Kindergarten team.

Afternoon pickup

Each grade has been allocated an entry point for parents of an afternoon. Pickup will be staggered. Please see the attached map for further details. Enter the school via the allocated gate, move to the collection point and then use the same gate to exit the school. Please consider others and maintain social distancing at all times.

Afternoon pickup Kindergarten, Year 1 & Year 2 @ 3pm

Kindergarten - Wilbeforce Ave stairs

Year 1 - Wilbeforce Ave gate

Year 2 - Albemarle Ave gate near pedestrian crossing

Afternoon pickup Year 3-6 @ 3.20pm

Year 3 - Wilbeforce Ave ramp

Year 4 - Albemarle Ave stairs near RBOOSH

Year 5 & 6 - Albemarle Ave car park gate

Students attending OOSH

Students in K-2 will attend RBOOSH from 3pm and students in Years 3-6 will attend from 3.20pm.

Students using the car pickup line on Wilbeforce Ave

Whilst we anticipate many of you will want to use the car pickup line, we encourage parents to collect their children from the designated collection point. Where possible, we would suggest that car pickup line is a last choice to avoid long queues and an extremely long wait. Older siblings should collect younger siblings and proceed to the pickup line as normal at 3.20pm. Parents, please remember the go-with-the-flow rules, no parking and remain in your car.

Siblings

For parents picking up more than one child in their family, please go to the youngest child's area. Older siblings will meet you at the allotted area. For example if you have a child in Year 1, Year 2 and Year 5, please go to the Year 1 area for pickup.

It all sounds complicated but it's not! No doubt there will be some teething issues as we implement these drop off and collection procedures. We will continue to refine and make improvements as we go, as these procedures will be with us for the foreseeable future. As a community I know we can work together to implement these procedures and work towards being Covid Safe. We have done such an amazing job Rose Bay, I know we can make this a great success.
