School Planning 2021 - 2024

At Rose Bay Public School, we are working behind the scenes, planning our community input into our new School Plan 2021-2024. School Plans have been renamed Strategic Improvement Plans (SIP). They provide a sustained focus on improving our strengths, as well as other areas for growth.

All our staff are engaged in revisiting our school vision and unpacking the products, practices and processes employed at our school to determine what we should retain, retire or refresh. The next step will be to refine and analyse these.

Our students are regularly engaged with robotics, using the Lego WeDo and WeCan kits as well as the beloved Beebots. In our library flexible learning space, students have been busy showcasing their collaborative and technical skills. Using high level, hands-on opportunities to build and code lego creations, students have constructed models to simulate real world scenarios by defining problems and designing solutions.
