Rose Bay Public School: leading the way with technology

Led by Ms. Mullens, the Stage 3 teachers have been working with a group of students on an augmented reality (AR) project. Using iPads, the students created the four seasons as worlds and users can tour and play in each world. This can be seen if you visit the art show. On Tuesday this week Ms. Mullens was asked by Apple to present at an Apple Education event for educators Australia-wide. She was able to discuss the project and the educational processes used by the students to develop the AR. Rose Bay Public School is leading the way with authentically using technology!

NAPLAN

Our school NAPLAN results have been released and earlier this week the student NAPLAN reports were posted home. NAPLAN is one set of data which records a snapshot of Year 3, 5, 7 & 9 students' achievements in time. This year Rose Bay Public School has seen an increase in most learning areas. In Year 3 there was an increase in reading, spelling, grammar and punctuation and a similar result in numeracy. In Year 5 there has been an increase in reading, writing, spelling and numeracy. An amazing achievement! This demonstrates the professionalism, expertise and dedication of all our teachers. Please note that there is no growth data this year as the Year 5 cohort did not sit the test in 2020 due to COVID.
