# far West Experience

# Cultural Immersion - Broken Hill & Menindee

Earlier this term, Miss Mullens and Miss Johnson spent the week in Far West New South Wales with other teachers from the Bondi and Strathfield Networks. We spent 2 days in Broken Hill, visiting and connecting with schools in the area and discussing and sharing how different schools cater for High Potential and Gifted students in the academic, physical, creative and social domains.











Then, we travelled to Menindee, a small community with a big heart, situated on the banks of the Darling River.







Our most enlightening and emotionally impactful experience was our visit to the Old Mission, located just outside Menindee. The Mission was established in the 1930s to displace Aboriginal people from their land and confine them to a government monitored property. Here we listened to stories told first hand by men of the Stolen Generation and the principal of Menindee Central School who generously shared her own family history. These stories of resilience and determination have helped us to learn and understand and highlight the importance of open dialogue.

On our return, we have worked with students across classrooms from Kindergarten to Year 6 to tell the stories of our adventures. Students have been highly engaged and we are proud to see our students wanting to make change in our community.

This week, we shared these stories and our students' work with Murat Dizdar's Executive Leadership Group at Homebush Boys High. We discussed the impact that this experience has had and the possibilities of ongoing relationships and connections between schools in the city and in rural and remote areas. We shared our student's fabulous work which highlights the impact that these opportunities can have in our classrooms.









We are so grateful for this opportunity, most importantly the chance to listen, learn and reflect in the Far West, and are excited to see these connections grow in the future.




